Information/Clarification about Tuition Payments & Rates

1. Tuition Assistance is available to families who qualify. For more information, please see Tuition Assistance under the Admissions tab on our website.
2. The **Public School Calendar** applies only to the academic calendar which begins on August 31, 2026 and ends on June 14, 2027. The calendar loosely follows the Danbury public school calendar. It is payable in 10 monthly installments or one discounted annual payment.
3. The **School & Vacation** calendar includes the academic calendar plus our vacation program during school vacations. The 10 month calendar includes dates from August 31, 2026 to June 11, 2027 and is paid in 10 installments. The 12 month calendar includes dates from August 31, 2026 to August 20, 2027 and is paid in 12 installments. Vacation program does not operate during national holidays and select school closing days (see calendar for details).
4. Tuition is paid in advance. The first monthly installment is due on the last day of the month prior to starting.
5. There is a 5% discount if an annual cash/check/credit card payment is made in full prior to August 1, 2026.
6. There is a 5% discount for military and National Guard personnel.
7. There is a sibling discount of 5% for each sibling when the siblings are enrolled at the same time (excluding School Readiness students).
8. A non-refundable prepayment of \$250 tuition is required to hold a place for your child. Payment is applied to your last tuition payment.
9. School Year Tuition schedule is effective June 1st 2024 and is subject to change.
10. A prepayment of \$500 is required to hold a place for your child. Of the \$500 prepayment, \$250 is a non-refundable application fee and \$250 will be credited to your last payment. This fee reserves a start date for up to 90 days. If your child does not begin attendance within that time period, the reservation will expire and the fee will be forfeited.
11. There is a 2.5% convenience fee for all credit card payments.
12. Snow and other emergency closing days are only made-up if the number exceeds seven days in one school year.
13. School may switch to online/distance learning for health/safety reasons.
14. There is a \$50 per month late fee for accounts that are delinquent. Service may be denied when tuition is delinquent.
15. Early session and late session programs are available 2 days, 3 days and 4 days per week. The part time rate is 70%, 80% and 90% of the five day rate respectively.
16. HCMS is 501(c)(3) non-profit. Some portions of tuition may be eligible for the child care tax credit.
